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## PREFACE

The Division of Livestock Planning and Economics (LPE) collects livestock-related data from various government and non-governmental organizations, since it has become an obligatory function to compile, analyze and maintain statistics of all industries ensuring usage and identify current issues, trends and gaps in the sector.

Livestock Planning and Economics division maintains several databases providing information on animal population, number of farms and livestock production etc. collected data through Government Veterinary Offices covering Whole Island. The division also obtains data such as import, export, prices of livestock products etc. from Sri Lanka Customs and various other sources.

Therefore, I would like to extend my sincere gratitude to all the data providers and contribute this publication to be a reality. I acknowledged the efforts of all Provincial Directors (PD), Deputy Provincial Directors (DPD), District Veterinary Surgeons (DVS), Government Veterinary Surgeons (GVS), Livestock Development Instructors (LDI) and all the other provincial officials for providing all requested data in time. Also, other data providers of the government sector such as NLDB, MILCO, Department of Census and Statistics, Department of Customs and private organizations viz. dairy producers, milk processors, and poultry producers are also well appreciated.

At the same time, I am thankful to all the Veterinary Surgeons (VS), Livestock Development Officers (LDO) and Development Officers (DO) in LPE Division for collecting, compiling and invaluable contribution made to analyzing and summarizing them.

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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

At present, the livestock sector's contribution to the total GDP is 1.4% at current price. Future planning for further development based on past trends and forecasting is an obligatory requirement of the industry. In this scenario, data pertaining to the livestock sector need to be collected, analyzed, and interpreted.

Based on the collected data, the analysis revealed that the cattle population in 2024 decreased by 2.6%, and the buffalo population decreased by 4.5% compared to 2023. Despite this situation, the total milk production in 2024 increased by 5.6% compared to 2023. Formal milk collection in the country in 2024 increased by 2.9%. Imports of milk and milk products decreased by 5% compared to 2023, and the annual per capita availability of milk in 2024 increased to 40.30 L from 39.98 L in 2023 as a result of increased local milk production.

Chicken meat production increased by 9.5%, whereas egg production increased by 44.5% in 2024. Therefore, the per capita availability of chicken meat increased by 10.9% in 2024. The annual per capita availability of eggs increased from 99.74 eggs in 2023 to 137.72 eggs in 2024. The availability of broiler day-old chicks in 2024 increased by 12.6%, while the production of layer day-old chicks showed a significant increase of nearly 61%. Furthermore, commercial poultry feed production also increased by 19% to support the growth of the poultry industry. The average retail price of an egg in 2024 was around Rs. 47.00, while the price of a whole chicken was around Rs. 1,325.00. However there was a deficit in egg production during the 1<sup>st</sup> half of year 2024, and thus table eggs were imported to fulfil the gap in requirement.

Goat production is still recognized as a traditional form of livestock production among farmers, especially in the dry zone. Out of the total population of 742,647, the majority is concentrated in the dry and intermediate zones. The highest population (277,264) was reported in the Eastern Province, and 65% of the total goat population is located in the Eastern and Northern provinces. The mutton, which is the main output of the goat industry, is around 2.66 ('000 MT), resulting in per capita consumption of 0.15 kg per year in 2024. During the year 2024, market price of mutton ranged from Rs.3,151/kg to Rs.3,347 with an average price of Rs.3,264/kg.

Beef production slightly increased to 29.79 ('000 MT), and per capita availability is around 1.37 kg/year in 2024. The average retail price of beef is around Rs. 2,183.00/kg.

In 2024, the swine population in Sri Lanka was recorded as 94,986 animals, primarily concentrated along the western coastal belt. A significant proportion – 50,465 animals – was reared in the Western and North Western provinces. Total pork production for the year 2024 was 8.96 ('000 MT), resulting in a per capita consumption of 0.41 kg per year. However, the outbreak of African Swine Fever (ASF) in the latter part of the year had a severe impact on the swine industry. The disease disrupted production and led to a decline in pork output by 4.4% compared to 2023.

# INTRODUCTION

Small-scale farming is still the major category in the livestock sector in Sri Lanka where their livelihood involves with minimum labour, commonly available feed resources and marginal lands. However, going in parallel to crop production, livestock farming is also improving with new knowledge and technologies and by upgrading the genetic potential of animals for improvement of the productivity of animals in the last decade.

In compared to the industry and other service-providing sectors, agriculture-based sectors are still slow growing and therefore the contribution of agriculture, forestry and fisheries sectors to the national GDP at current prices, still remains at 8.3% in 2024 (DCS website), while the contribution of livestock alone was at 1.4% for the recent years.

The consumption of livestock products has been increased dramatically over the last two decades along with the increase in per capita income, urbanization and sociocultural changes. Livestock production, while helping to improve the nutritional status of the country, it also offers many livelihood opportunities for people in the country directly and indirectly. Most of the livestock products such as milk, meat and eggs are now converting to numerous value-added products and some of those are exported to other countries. In addition, some of the byproducts generating from the livestock industry utilize as raw materials in other industries. Livestock waste is also utilized in renewable energy production (Biogas), which helps reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Domestic biogas units associated with cattle and pig farming have proven as successful alternative energy source for many domestic energy needs in rural areas of the country. The nature and the labour-intensiveness of many livestock operations effectively harnessed for rural employment creation, livelihood improvement and poverty alleviation.

## *Dairy Sector*

Historically dairy animals have been kept to serve multiple purposes such as producing milk for household consumption, male animals for paddy cultivation and transport of goods and people and dung as an organic fertilizer and fuel. They may act as a capital reserve and provide employment to help farmers over lean periods and give greater income stability. Presently, it is one of the major employments of rural communities.

Dairy animals generate a continuous flow of income and act as a cushion against income shocks arising in any disaster of earnings. Milk is a 'cash crop' for smallholders, converting low-value agricultural byproducts, crop residues and cheap family labor into a value-added market commodity. Regular milk sales allow them to move from subsistence to earning a market-based income.

Although small-scale dairying is still predominant in the country, it is in a transitional period to convert to medium and large-scale farms resulting conversion of livelihood operations of the system to a profitable industry. Further, the growing trends for organic farming will open another window for market-based income. Accommodation of local production in the market chain has become a challenge. Therefore, the development of infrastructure such as milk collecting networks, facilities for value addition and further processing and quality assurance will be required for smooth growth of the industry.

Of the 392 million liters of milk that was produced locally, the volume of milk entering the formal milk market in 2024 was 252.05 million liters while the rest was channeled through informal routes and also consumed domestically. Comparing to the previous year, milk production was increased by 5.6% and formal milk collection was increased 2.9% respectively.

### ***Poultry Sector***

The poultry industry has grown significantly after 1977 with economic reforms in Sri Lanka. The poultry population has increased exponentially from 6.3 million to 35.5 million in 2024. The production of chicken meat has grown by 72% and production of egg, by 32% during the past decade. The per capita consumption of chicken meat and egg had changed from 38 eggs in 1980 to 138 eggs in 2024. The poultry production is in private hands with forward contracts for input supplying and marketing mainly in small-scale broiler production. Therefore, small-scale rural farmers get their inputs at their doorstep and have to market their products at pre-agreed prices. The consumption needs of poultry products are totally supplied by domestic enterprises.

### ***Goat Sector***

Although Sri Lanka has a goat population of approximately 0.74 million, the goat industry is still not a well-established commercial sector in the country.

In the dry zone, goats are reared extensively, mainly for meat production, and milking is generally not practiced. Goat rearing forms an important part of the rural economy in this region; however, it is still pursued primarily as a secondary or tertiary source of income.

In other parts of the country, such as the Western, Central, and North Western Provinces, goats are reared for both meat and milk, and are managed under intensive and semi-intensive systems.

There is a growing demand for goat milk across most areas of the country due to its recognized health benefits, though in some regions milk marketing remains a challenge. Given these circumstances, it is now the right time to pay greater attention to the goat industry in Sri Lanka. Strengthening this sector could help the country save a significant amount of foreign exchange currently spent on importing goat meat, which amounted to 880.98 million rupees in 2024.

### ***Swine Sector***

Pig production in Sri Lanka is primarily concentrated along the coastal belt of the Western and North Western provinces. The swine population has remained relatively stable at around 80,000 animals over the past decades. Pork production in the country is supported by a mix of highly commercialized large-scale farms utilizing three-way crossbreeds (Landrace, Large White, and Duroc), medium-scale intensive farms, and semi-intensive backyard farms that rear crosses of indigenous pigs.

Accurate and reliable data are a prerequisite for effective future development planning in the livestock industry. In this context, it is essential to collect, analyze, interpret, and disseminate data related to the livestock sector. The objective of this document is to compile and present the collected data for the benefit of planners and policymakers, enabling them informed to take decisions for the sustainable development of the livestock industry in the country.



## METHODOLOGY

Data for this document were collected from several government and private agencies, and some of the data were analyzed to obtain annual figures. Economic models and formulas were used to estimate the values. Data collected from reports, sample surveys by the LPE Division, and secondary data published by other agencies were utilized in these models.

Figures on farm numbers and animal populations (cattle, buffaloes, goats, sheep, pigs, and poultry) were compiled and presented using data collected from 337 divisional veterinary ranges, following a standard format to gather information on the livestock sector. It was assumed that the data submitted were from registered farms within these veterinary ranges.

Slaughter statistics obtained from the Department of Census and Statistics (DCS) and data from the LPE survey were used to estimate meat production. The poultry population, chicken meat production, egg production, and commercial chick production were estimated using monthly reports provided by poultry breeders and processors.

Milk production was estimated using milk collection data from 14 major milk-collecting agencies and the monthly data submitted by all veterinary offices in the country.

Data on imports and exports of milk and meat were obtained from the Statistics Division of Sri Lanka Customs. Import data for animal feed ingredients were also obtained from Sri Lanka Customs and the Animal Quarantine Stations of the Department of Animal Production and Health (DAPH).

Data collected from the Veterinary Regulatory Affairs (VRA) division of DAPH were used in estimating animal feed production. Local production of animal feed ingredients was obtained from the Department of Census and Statistics.

Compound feed prices were gathered from feed manufacturers, while retail prices of feed ingredients were collected from the Colombo market. Prices for poultry and poultry products were obtained from breeders and commercial poultry farms. Retail market prices for livestock products were obtained from reports published by HARTI (Hector Kobbekaduwa Agrarian Research and Training Institute).

Some of the information provided in this bulletin were compiled and analyzed by the Division of Livestock Planning and Economics (LPE), DAPH, to present annual values, production estimates, economic indicators, and trends in livestock production.
