1. Submit the relevant documents at the Animal Quarantine Office.
2. Document verification and registration
 - a. Customs (Duly Endorsed) declaration form.
 - b. Import approval original from Animal Quarantine Office

- ❖ **All the relevant documents of the consignment are checked by the AQ officers and when the requirements are fulfilled, the consignment is registered at the Quarantine Office.**
3. Final releasement of the consignment from the Animal Quarantine, when all the requirements are fulfilled.
- ❖ **If noncompliance is observed at the point of document verification & physical inspection, the consignment will be detained including the satisfactory microbiology reports.**
