Leather:

1. Submit the relevant documents at the Animal Quarantine Office
 2. Document verification and registration
 - a. Customs (Duly endorsed) declaration form
 - b. Import approval original from DAPH**

 - a. Original International Veterinary Health Certificate from Government Veterinary Authority (in accordance with DAPH approval)
 - c. Country of origin (Original).
 - d. Bill of Lading/Airway Bill.
 - e. Commercial Invoice.
 - f. Packing list.
 - g. Delivery order.
- ❖ All the relevant documents of the consignment are checked by the AQ officers and when the requirements are fulfilled, the consignment is registered at the Quarantine Office.
3. Physical inspection by Animal Quarantine Officers at Custom Examination Yard /Ware house.
 4. Final releasement of the consignment from the Animal Quarantine, when all the requirements are fulfilled.
- ❖ If noncompliance is observed at the point of document verification & physical inspection, the consignment will be detained.

Bristles and feathers:

1. Submit the relevant documents at the Animal Quarantine Office
2. Document verification and registration

3. Fumigation and Physical inspection by Animal Quarantine Officers at warehouse.
4. Final releasement of the consignment from the Animal Quarantine, when all the requirements are fulfilled.
