## **Live Animals**

- 1. Submit the relevant documents at the Animal Quarantine Office
- 2. Document verification and registration
  - a. Customs Duly endorsed declaration form.
  - b. Import approval original from DAPH

  - c. Original International Veterinary Health Certificate from Government Veterinary Authority (in accordance with the DAPH approval).
  - d. Commercial Invoice.
  - e. Packing list
  - f. Bill of Laden,
  - g. Delivery order
  - h. Test reports, Vaccination and treatment records.
- ❖ All the relevant documents of the consignment are checked by the Animal Quarantine officers and when the requirements are fulfilled, the consignment is registered at the Quarantine Office.
- 3. Physical Inspection by Animal Quarantine Officers at the port of entry.
- 4. Animals will be subjected to quarantine for a period of not less than 30 days except Ornamental Fish (For ornamental fish -14 days) upon arrival. During that period animals will be subjected to necessary testing, vaccination and treatment.
- 5. If any noncompliance occurs during that period, the quarantine period will be extended.
- 6. Final releasement of the consignment from the Animal Quarantine, when all the requirements are fulfilled.

## **Import of Live fish**

- 1. Submit the relevant documents at the Animal Quarantine Office
- 2. Document verification and registration
  - a. Customs duly endorsed declaration form.
  - b. Import approval original from DAPH

  - c. Original International Veterinary Health Certificate from Government Veterinary Authority (in accordance with the DAPH approval).
  - d. Test reports
  - e. Commercial Invoice.
  - f. Packing list
- ❖ All the relevant documents of the consignment are checked by the Animal Quarantine officers and when the requirements are fulfilled, the consignment is registered at the Quarantine Office.
- 1. Physical Inspection by Animal Quarantine Officers and Animal Quarantine inspectors at the port of entry.
- 2. Samples will be collected at the Airport
- 3. Animals will be subjected to quarantine for a period of 14 days and during that period animals will be subjected to testing and treatment.
- 4. If any noncompliance occurs during that period, the quarantine period will be extended.
- 5. Final releasement of the consignment from the Animal Quarantine, when all the requirements are fulfilled.
