- g. Packing list
- h. Delivery order.
- i. Microbiology report. (For Meat, Casing & Chicken products)
- ❖ All the relevant documents of the consignment are checked by the AQ officers and when the requirements are fulfilled, the consignment is registered at the Quarantine Office.
- 3. Physical inspection by Animal Quarantine Officers at Custom Examination Yard /Seaport.
- 4. Sample collection by Animal Quarantine Officers at ware house.
- 5. Final releasement of the consignment from the Animal Quarantine, when all the requirements are fulfilled with the satisfactory laboratory reports.
- **❖** If noncompliance is observed at the point of document verification & physical inspection, the consignment will be detained including the satisfactory microbiology reports.
