- 1. Submit the relevant documents at the Animal Quarantine Office
- 2. Document verification and registration
 - a. Customs Duly endorsed) declaration form.
 - b. Import approval original from DAPH

 - c. Country of Origin (Original).
 - d. Commercial Invoice.
 - e. Packing list (with production date, expiry date & lot no.)
 - f. Bill of Laden,
 - g. Delivery order,
 - h. Analysis reports
- **All the relevant documents of the consignment are checked by the AQ officers and when the requirements are fulfilled, the consignment is registered at the Quarantine Office.**
- 3. Final releasement of the consignment from the Animal Quarantine, when all the requirements are fulfilled.
- **❖** If noncompliance is observed at the point of document verification & physical inspection, the consignment will be detained.
- 4. Appeal and review
- 5. Rejected goods
