

Animal By Products

The International Veterinary Health Certificate (IVHC) is issued by the Animal Quarantine Office for approved establishments by the Department of Animal Production & Health (DAPH). (Mention the DAPH link for registration procedures)

Pre-Export Quarantine Process

Exporter should submit the following documents to the Animal Quarantine office.

- a. Copy of the approval of DAPH as a By-product establishment/ exporter.
- b. Copy of the DAPH registration as a By-product establishment/ exporter.
- c. Copy of the business registration certificate

Issuance of IVHC

1. Perform pretreatment and microbiological analysis (per consignment) according to the importing country requirements.
2. Submission of the following documents to the Animal Quarantine Office to obtain the IVHC.
 - a. Duly filled application.
 - b. Commercial Invoice
 - c. Packing list
 - d. Pretreatment certificate
 - e. Microbiology report
2. Verification of the documents.
3. Paying the relevant fees. (Mention the link to fees)
4. Issuing of IVHC.

It is the exporter's responsibility to fulfill the importing country requirements and Animal Quarantine is not liable for any consequences due to failure of completing the requirements.
