

Companion Animals

1. Submission of the filled application **Five** working days before the issuance of the IVHC with the following documents to get the appointment date and time (hard copy or email).
 - Rabies vaccination records
 - Microchip Number (Depending on the Importing Country requirements)
 - Specific requirements of the importing country.
 - ◆ Import permit.
 - ◆ Rabies titer test results.
 - ◆ Other vaccination records.
 - ◆ Parasitic treatments
 - ◆ Relevant annexures
2. When the owner is not available to visit AQO (but still he/she is the exporter), then the authorized person shall submit an authorization letter at the time of visiting.
3. When certain conditions required by the competent Authority of the importing country are not filled, a liability letter is needed at the time of visiting.

Issuance of the certificate

1. Submit the originals with the set of photocopies of the following documents at the time of document verification on obtaining IVHC.
 - Rabies vaccination records (Original)
 - Microchip Number (Depending on the Importing Country requirements)
 - Specific requirements of the importing country.
 - Import permit.
 - Rabies titer test results.
 - Other vaccination records.
 - Parasitic treatments
 - Relevant annexures
 - Liability letter (if applicable)
 - Authorization letter (if applicable)
 2. Physical Examination of the pet.
 3. Pay the relevant fees (mention the link for the fees).
 4. Issuance of the certificate.
- ❖ One certificate is issued for one animal.
 - ❖ **It is the exporter's responsibility to fulfil the importing country's requirements and Animal Quarantine is not liable for any consequences due to failure to complete the requirements.**
 - ❖ **The validity period of the certificate will be 7 days from the issued date.**
