

Large Animals & Zoo Animals

1. Inform the Animal quarantine office of the export consignment with the following documents five working days before the beginning of the quarantine period.
 - a. Expected quarantine starting date
 - b. Destination (country)
 - c. Types of animals planned to be exported
 - d. Identification of the animals, Age, Number, and Sex of the animals
 - e. Planned date of departure
2. Abide by the rules and regulations stipulated by the Animal Quarantine Service
3. Inspection of the pre-export Quarantine site of the farm animals /Zoo animals.
4. Implementation of the quarantine process. The duration of the quarantine period will be decided according to the importing country's requirements.
5. Vaccination, testing and pre-treatment.

Issuance of the IVHC certificate

1. Submission of the application for the IVHC with the complete set of documents 5 working days before the departure date.
 - a. Import Permit if applicable
 - b. Vaccination records
 - c. Testing reports
 - d. Pre-treatment records
 - e. Wildlife permit (if necessary)
 - f. Other documents relevant to the country requirement
2. Verification of the documents.
3. Paying off the relevant fees (Mention the link to fees).
4. Issuing the International Veterinary Health Certificate.

It is the exporter's responsibility to fulfil the importing country's requirements and Animal Quarantine is not liable for any consequences due to failure of completing the requirements.

The validity period of the certificate will be 7 days from the issued date.
