Table Eggs

The International Veterinary Health Certificate (IVHC) is issued by the Animal Quarantine Office for approved establishments by the Department of Animal Production & Health (DAPH). (Mention the DAPH link for registration procedures)

Pre-Export Quarantine Process

Exporter should submit the following documents to the Animal Quarantine office.

- a. Copy of the approval of DAPH as a Poultry farm establishment for table eggs
- b. Copy of the DAPH registration as a poultry farm establishment for table eggs.
- c. Copy of the business registration certificate.
- d. Copy of Environmental authority approval.
- e. Sketch diagram of the location of the table egg establishment
- f. Declaration for ownership of the land of the quarantine site. (Should be attested by a legal officer)

Issuance of the IVHC

- 1. Submit the following documents to the Animal Quarantine Office to obtain the IVHC.
 - a. Duly filled application
 - b. Commercial invoice
 - c. Packing list
- Submission of relevant documents for IVHC (Application, Commercial invoice & Packing list).
- 3. Verification of the documents.
- 4. Paying the fees. (mention the link to fees)
- 5. Issuing of the IVHC.

It is the exporter's responsibility to fulfill the importing country requirements and Animal Quarantine is not liable for any consequences due to failure of completing the requirements.

Validity period of the certificate will be 7 days from the date of issue for air and 21 days for sea.
