**Veterinary health requirements for the importation of pet birds into Sri Lanka**

Following status should be met

Status	Disease / Organism	Required test/ Certification
Country free	<i>Notifiable Avian Influenza(NAI)</i>	Certification by the Government Veterinary Authority
Aviary/ Source flock/s free	Avian Leucosis Avian encephalomyelitis Avian papovavirus Avian Pox virus infection Chlamydiosis Newcastle disease Pacheco's disease Psittacine beak and feather disease Fowl cholera Salmonellosis Pssitacine reovirus infection	Certification by the Government Veterinary Authority (free of diseases for a period of 06 (six) months immediately prior to date of export of bird/s to Sri Lanka)
Tests	<i>Notifiable Avian Influenza(NAI)</i>	Cloacal swabs should be tested to detect Avian Influenza Virus 7 days prior to export
Treatments	Internal and External parasites	Broad-spectrum anti-parasiticide seven days prior to embarkation

Only adult pet bird/s of *more than 1 year old* is allowed to import.

The bird/s that are expected to be exported should be

- I. Born & bred in the same establishment that they are kept before export.
- I. Examined on the day of dispatch to ensure they are clinically healthy without any deformity and are fit to be exported by the Govt. Veterinary authority
- II. Bird/s should be marked with identification numbers using wing bands/ leg bands/ finger bands

The certificate of the country of origin should be certified by the relevant authority

*Health protocol may vary from time to time according to the disease status reported to OIE and the health status of the exporting country*
