Veterinary health requirements for the importation of Hatchable / Hatching eggs into Sri Lanka


Following status should be met

Status	Disease / Organism	Required test / Certification
Compartment free	<i>Notifiable Avian Influenza (NAI)</i>	Veterinary Authority should certify that the compartment is in accordance with Chapter 10.4.9 in Terrestrial Animal Health Code
Farm free	<i>Newcastle disease</i> <i>salmonellosis</i> including Fowl typhoid and Pullorum disease, <i>Mycoplasmosis</i> , (<i>M. gallisepticum</i> and <i>M. synoviae</i>), <i>Infectious laryngotracheitis</i> , <i>Infectious bronchitis</i> , <i>Infectious bursal disease</i> , <i>Avian leukosis</i> , <i>Reticuloendotheliasis</i> , <i>Egg drop syndrome</i> , <i>Avian Reo virus infections</i> , <i>Avian encephalomyelitis</i> , <i>Swollen head syndrome</i> , <i>Mareks' Disease</i> , <i>Chicken anemia</i> , <i>Adenovirus-Inclusion body hepatitis</i> , <i>Ornitho bacteriosis</i>	Certification of the Government Veterinary Authority that the farm is free for a period of 01 (one) year immediately prior to the date of export to Sri Lanka
Vaccination	<i>ND</i> , <i>Infectious laryngotracheitis</i> , <i>Infectious bronchitis</i> , <i>Infectious bursal disease</i> , <i>Avian leucosis</i> , <i>Egg drop syndrome</i> , <i>Avian Reovirus infection</i> <i>Avian encephalomyelitis</i> , <i>Marek's disease</i>	Vaccinated with WOAH-recommended vaccines and protocols <i>CV 1988 (Rispens) serotype I</i> ; <i>CV 1988 (Rispens) serotype I + HVT serotype III</i> ; or <i>SB I serotype II + HVT serotype III</i>

General conditions

- The farm (Parent / Grandparent) intended to be exported to Sri Lanka does not adopt a vaccination programme against avian influenza.
- The certificate of the country of origin should be certified by the relevant authority

Health protocol may vary from time to time according to the disease status reported to OIE and the health status of the exporting country
