Veterinary health requirements for the importation of Table eggs into Sri Lanka

The following requirements should be fulfilled

Status	Disease / Organism	Required test / Certification
Compartment free	<i>Notifiable Avian Influenza (NAI)</i>	Government Veterinary Authority should certify that the compartment is free for past three (03) months in accordance with Chapter 10.4.9 of Terrestrial Animal Health Code
Tests	Salmonella species including <i>Salmonella enteritidis</i> , Velogenic New Castle Disease	Eggs should be serologically negative according to WOAHP prior to export

General Conditions

1. The eggs (Only natural eggs are permitted) are unfertilized and derived from layer flocks kept in a farm accredited/registered for the export purpose of eggs by the State Veterinary Authority of the exporting country.
2. The eggs have a fully developed shell and were cleaned, fresh and fit for human consumption
3. The eggs have been handled and packed in appropriately sanitized packaging materials and containers in a hygienic manner
4. Additives and/or coloring matters injurious to health have not been added.
5. Eggs exported from each farm shall be accompanied by a veterinary certificate dated within 7 days of export
6. Eggs should be transported in reefer containers. The temperature must be maintained throughout such that the products would maintain in sanitary and fresh condition.
7. The eggs must be labeled with a unique identifier code, issued by the competent authority of exporting country to identify the producing farm.
