Veterinary health requirements for the importation of frozen Mutton / Lamb meat into Sri Lanka

The following requirements should be fulfilled

Status	Disease / Organism	Required test / Certification
Country free	Peste des petits ruminants. Scrapie Sheep and Goat pox	Certification by the Government Veterinary Authority
Zone free	Foot and Mouth Disease Anthrax Brucellosis	Certification by the Government Veterinary Authority
Animal free	Toxoplasma spp.	Certification by the Government Veterinary Authority
Stock free of importing consignment	E.coli, Staphylococcus aureus Salmonella species	Total aerobic plate count within the standard E.coli, (CFU/g) within the standard Staphylococcus aureus (CFU/g) within the standard Salmonella species (Negative)
Anti-mortem inspection	Animals should be healthy and free of diseases	Certification by the Government Veterinary Authority
post-mortem inspection	Echinococcus	Certification by the Government Veterinary Authority
Slaughterhouse		Registered and approved by Government Veterinary Authority
HACCP for processing establishment		A valid certificate from accrediting national authority
Heavy Metal / Anti- microbial Residues		Certification by the Government Veterinary Authority
Suitability for Human Consumption		Certification by the Government veterinary authority on suitability for Human consumption

The certificate of the country of origin should be certified by the relevant authority

Health protocol may vary from time to time according to the disease status reported to OIE and the health status of the exporting country
