

Should be issued by the Government Veterinary Authority in the exporting country, attesting that;

1. Dog Identity with a Microchip Number.
2. Dogs are above 04 months or more prior to export to Sri Lanka
3. Dog has been kept in the exporting country since birth or for the six (06) months period immediately prior to export to Sri Lanka;
4. The dog is clinically healthy, free from signs of any infectious and contagious diseases and without any deformity at the time of dispatch
5. The animal was not in contact with animals showing clinical signs of any infectious or contagious disease such as Aujeszky's disease, Filariasis, Leptospirosis, Rabies, Canine distemper, Infectious hepatitis, Canine parvo virus infection, and Dermatomycosis for a period of minimum three (03) months immediately prior to embarkation.
6. The exporting country of the animal is either free from rabies. If not, the origin of the animal is an area free from quarantine restrictions for rabies and not within a radius of 25 km from the nearest known case of rabies during the period of minimum six (06) months immediately prior to embarkation.
7. The dog was tested in a government approved /recognized laboratory for *Dirofilaria immitis* (Heart worm), Canine Babesiosis (*Babesia gibsoni* and *Babesia canis*), Leishmaniosis and SARS COV-2 Real time PCR Test and found negative.
